

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PARKING AT RUSH

The main parking garage at Rush has converted to an automated pay system, designed to make life easier for anyone who parks there. You have most likely used one of these systems at a movie theater, hotel or public parking garage.

What To Do:

- Pull a ticket when you enter patient and visitor parking lot and **take it with you**.
- Before returning to your vehicle, pay at one of the seven pay stations conveniently located on the fourth floor — **credit or debit cards now accepted, along with cash**.
- Take the paid ticket and proceed to your car.
- Insert the paid ticket into the machine at the exit gate.
- If you forget to pay at the pay station, you can always pay in the exit lane by debit or credit card.
- You have 20 minutes to exit after paying at the pay station. If you feel you will need more time, you can pay at exit gate with debit or credit card.



Parking staff will be stationed near all of the pay stations for several months to assist patients and visitors with questions about how to use the system.

An attendant also will remain at the visitor exit gate during this period for further assistance
Parking rates will remain the same.
